



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HIRERS USING BOUNCY CASTLES

This information is to ensure that a low-height bouncy castle is used safely, and that there is no damage to the hall as a result.

The hall has a grid ceiling, containing LED panels, emergency lighting and insulation boards. Jumping to reach the ceiling could result in damage to these fixtures, plus injury if the items fall. Such damage will also be very expensive to repair. Hirers accept full responsibility for any injury or damage caused.

Castle supply and documentation

- All bouncy castles must be from an official supplier. The hall insurance prohibits castles owned by private individuals.
- Hirers must provide the supplier's public liability insurance and electrical safety certificate to the booking secretary, at least 5 days before the event.

Castle Size and use

- Maximum height is 8 feet (2.4 metres) to ensure ceiling clearance.
- The castle must NOT be used by any child aged over 6 years, nor by adults. This is regardless of the supplier age rating for the castle.
- Hirers are responsible for complying with the supplier's conditions, and for supervising use throughout the event.

Castle Location

- The castle must be placed at the south end of the main room, nearest the entrance hall. If possible the castle should be positioned away from the LED panels. The other end of the room is not suitable due to the ceiling spotlights.
- The castle should be placed clear of the walls.

The hall is not suitable for other inflatables or ball games. This is to prevent damage. Hirers are also asked to protect our flooring by not permitting sliding or spiked shoes.
